The official WIC program is available to low to moderate income pregnant women, recently delivered women, breastfeeding women, infants, and children up to age 5 who are at nutrition risk. Fathers can also bring their children to apply for WIC. You may apply for WIC if you are working or unemployed. Participants receive checks each month that are used to buy specific nutritious foods at grocery stores.

Working collaboratively with the Indiana Department of Children's Services (DCS), Family Ark has provided quality services to children and their families for more than four decades. Family Ark's services include foster care, community based services, and behavioral health services. Whenever possible, we will seek to keep the child in the home of his/her biological family while working toward overall improvement within the family system. When it is necessary to remove a child from the parents' home we will attempt to keep the child in the family's geographical area to facilitate contact and seek reunification as quickly as therapeutically possible.


