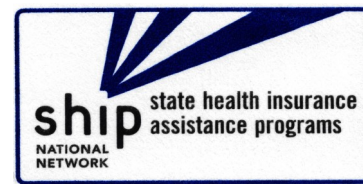

The Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) is for children up to age 19 whose families have slightly higher incomes. In CHIP, members are required to pay a low monthly premium for coverage as well as copays for certain services.

Head Start is a family centered child development program for three and four year old's. Our comprehensive services provide opportunities that help children to develop school readiness skills and assist families in recognizing their role as their child's first and most important teacher. Nutritious meals are served daily. Transportation is provided where possible. Families must meet income eligibility requirements.
